Unplug from the grid, pause and soak up the magnificence of these ancient landscapes bought vividly to life by the people you'll meet on the way.





29 suites offer panoramic windows with views over the powerful North Atlantic Ocean, Most have wood burning stoves and all are furnished with local fabrics and handmade furniture, a quietly thoughtful step away from the usual conservative hotel room design.

# Neddies Harbour Inn, Gros Morne

It would be hard to beat the location of Neddies Harbour Inn. Set on Norris Point, Neddies is in the heart of the Gros Morne National Park so expect magnificent views and a tranquil location.
